

ORDINANCE NO. 1990 (5)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN ROADS INTO THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Hopkins County to agree to and to allow certain roads to be taken into the Hopkins County road system.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that the County should enter into an Agreement allowing or accepting the right-of-way for a certain road located near White Plains, Kentucky, said road known as the Dragline Road and a road located near St. Charles, Kentucky, known as the Rialto Road.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has further determined that the owners of said properties, will agree to upgrade said roads and to provide a gravel or stone surface on said roads and to grant a right-of-way to Hopkins County for said roads.

It was further determined by the Hopkins County Fiscal Court that the road known as the Dragline Road would be accepted into the county road system with an agreement by the County that the road would be closed with the right-of-way reverting back to the owners of said property, at the request of the property owner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the County of Hopkins, Commonwealth of Kentucky, as follows:

1. That Hopkins County, Kentucky, agrees to accept the roadway and right-of-way known as the Dragline Road, into the county road system once the owners of said property upgrade said road and provide a gravel or stone surface on said roadway, with a provision that the road will be closed by the County at the request of the property owner, who is granting the right-of-way for said property, and that if and when said road is closed, that said right-of-way shall revert back to the owner of said property.


2. That the roadway known as the Rialto Road shall be accepted into the Hopkins County Road system once this roadway is upgraded and a gravel or stone surface is applied.

UPON MOTION by Welch, seconded by Lynn, approved at first reading by the Hopkins County Fiscal Court on the 20th day of July, 1990.
