

ORDINANCE NO. 1993( /)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE ACQUISITION AND USE OF A STICKER GRANTING PERMISSION TO USE THE HOPKINS COUNTY CONVENIENCE CENTERS.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that it is in the best interest of Hopkins County in the operation of its garbage collection systems at convenience centers throughout Hopkins County to allow persons living in Hopkins County to acquire stickers for their automobiles which grant permission to use the convenience centers.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that persons living in Hopkins County and possessing a valid Kentucky operators license, issued in Hopkins County, may apply for and be granted a window decal or sticker for their automobile. Any person so acquiring such a decal or sticker shall be allowed to use the convenience centers when this sticker is properly displayed.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has further determined that some persons are acquiring these stickers who do not live in Hopkins County and are using decals or stickers belonging to other persons to enable them to use the household solid waste collection convenience centers throughout Hopkins County.

The Hopkins County Fiscal Court has determined that this is improper and that this must be controlled.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County of Hopkins, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that any person holding a valid

operators license, issued in Hopkins County and residing in Hopkins County, Kentucky, or any person residing in Hopkins County who can prove their residence, or persons who own farms in Hopkins County and who must dispose of farm debris from those farms, may apply for and be granted a decal allowing them to dispose of household solid waste at the convenience centers throughout Hopkins County.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person, who is not a resident of Hopkins County, who improperly acquires a decal granting the right to use the Hopkins County Convenience Centers, or who disposes of household solid waste at the convenience centers without a properly acquired decal, shall be considered in violation of this ordinance and shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person granting other persons, who are not residents of Hopkins County, the use of their decal shall be in violation of this ordinance and that person's decal shall be forfeited and that person shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.

UPON MOTION by Squire Lynn, second by Squire Fugate, first reading was held and approved on the 9th day of February, 1993.
