

ORDINANCE NO. 1993(3)

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE NON-TAXING SOLID WASTE DISTRICT CREATED PURSUANT TO KRS 109.041(13) AND KRS 67.083(3)(0) AND TERMINATING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NON-TAXING SOLID WASTE DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that:

1. The Non-Taxing Solid Waste District created pursuant to KRS 109.041(13) and KRS 67.083(3)(0), which included the total area within the borders of Hopkins County, Kentucky, and which was called "The Hopkins County Solid Waste District", and which was created pursuant to Ordinance 1991(3) enacted on May 16, 1991, is hereby abolished.

2. The offices of the Board of Directors created pursuant to Ordinance 1991(3) are hereby terminated and abolished.

3. All powers previously granted to the Hopkins County Solid Waste District are further terminated and said powers and authority are returned to the Hopkins County Fiscal Court. The Hopkins County Fiscal Court shall exercise all of it's powers necessary for the management of solid waste in Hopkins County.

4. The Fiscal Court of Hopkins County shall serve as the official solid waste management area and the plans previously submitted to the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet of the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall continue in full force and effect. The Hopkins County Fiscal Court shall further submit any additional waste management plans and shall comply with Senate Bill 2 as enacted by the Special Session of the General

Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in 1991, and shall comply with all other provisions of KRS Chapter 224.

UPON MOTION by Fugate, second by Browning, first reading was held and approved on the 1 day of July, 1993.
