

ORDINANCE NO. 1994(3)

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE HOPKINS COUNTY
AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLAN AND CIVIL RIGHTS PLAN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the Affirmative Action Plan and Civil Rights Plan for Hopkins County is intended to be a broad program with built-in flexibility which will assure equal opportunity for all citizens of Hopkins County; and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County will endeavor to comply with Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and all of the provisions of Civil Rights Legislation relating to discrimination, federal programs and other county programs; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County will endeavor to identify problem areas within the county government to accomplish the stated objects of the Affirmative Action Plan and Civil Rights Plans; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Fiscal Court has the primary responsibility for the formulation and maintenance of an Affirmative Action Plan and Civil Rights Plan; and


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County, Kentucky, does hereby adopt the Affirmative Action Plan and Civil Rights Plan, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A" for identification, and that said plan and attachments are made a part of the Hopkins County Administrative Code.

UPON MOTION by Rodgers, second by Purdy, first reading was held and approved on the 3rd day of February, 1994.




