

ORDINANCE NO. 1995(1)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND AMENDMENT THEREOF

WHEREAS, the County of Hopkins has received unbudgeted revenues from Surplus from Prior Year, Energy Recovery, KST/Truck License Distr., KST/Drivers License, Interest on Investments, Interest on checking, Unmined Coal, Fire Protection, Deed Transfer, Reimbursements, Scrap Iron Sales, Commercial Haulers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County as follows:
