

ORDINANCE NO. 1995(2)

AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE HOPKINS COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO PERSONNEL LEAVE POLICY

WHEREAS, the governing body of Hopkins County, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court, has received a recommendation from the County Judge/Executive to amend the Administrative Code of Hopkins County as the same pertains to Addendum B (Personnel Leave Policy), and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has determined that the recommendation of the County Judge/Executive directing that the Code be amended to direct the County to pay a decedent's estate for any unused vacation leave that exists at the death of an employee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the Administrative Code of Hopkins County be amended as follows:

Addendum B (Personnel Leave Policy) shall be amended as follows:


A. Vacation Leave:

4. Employees shall not be paid for unused vacation leave when leaving County employment and unused vacation leave shall not be applied toward retirement, provided however, that if the death of an employee occurs and should that employee have unused vacation leave, then the County shall pay said employee's estate for unused vacation.

The Administrative Code and the Personnel Leave Policy is amended or altered in no other respect.


This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.

was held and approved on the 2nd day of February, 1995.






