

**ORDINANCE 2003 – 7**

**AN ORDINANCE OF HOPKINS COUNTY, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO THE  
2003 TAX RATES FOR REAL PROPERTY IN HOPKINS COUNTY.**


Following proper notice for a public hearing and following the public hearing, and upon second reading of the ordinance the following county tax rates for 2003 were introduced and adopted.
