

**IN RE THE MATTER OF CLOSING A PORTION OF McCLEARN LANE FROM THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court on the Petition of Dennis and Wetonina Brasher has expressed the desire to remove from the County Road System a portion of a public road named McClearn Lane, which is described with more particularity as the last 250 feet thereof.

WHEREAS, notice was published according to KRS 178.050 and notices were placed at three public places in the vicinity of said road.

WHEREAS, two viewers were appointed by the Fiscal Court together with the County Road Supervisor, who viewed the proposed road closure and reported in writing to a public hearing held on October 6, 2005.

WHEREAS, their report stated that the advantages which will result to the individual and public are: N/A

WHEREAS, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court finds that closure of the subject road is in the public interest in the following respects: the road is not necessary for access to property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Hopkins County that the above-described portion of the public road named McClearn Lane shall be closed and removed from the Hopkins County Road System.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

Upon motion of Magistrate Duncan and seconded by Magistrate Garrett, the ordinance, was approved for its first reading on October 20, 2005. Whereupon the vote was called, and on roll call, the vote stood:




