individual has young handicapped children and bus needs to get to door to pick up; and <u>Raile Road</u>: (1) dead end road with tile installed; (2) driveway will be rocked which will allow the bus to travel down this road; (3) the road is 4530 feet long and (4) this is a dead end road without a legal turnaround.

WHEREAS, their report stated that the grades and bearings of the proposed turn-arounds are:

WHEREAS, the Hopkins County Fiscal Court finds that bringing into the county road system the above-captioned two school bus turn-arounds is in the public interest because it provides for more effective bus routes for school buses and the transportation of the county's children to the public education system.
